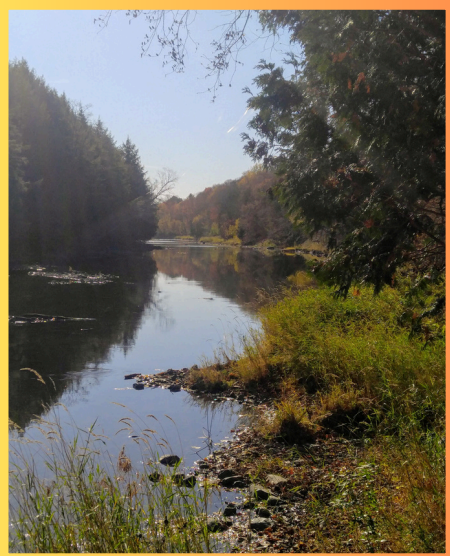


GREATER HOULTON & SOUTHERN AROOSTOOK VISIT BY THE DAY !

DAY 2

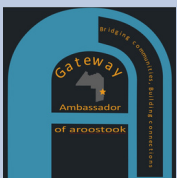
IN & AROUND TOWN

- Lunch at Shin Pond Village in Mount Chase

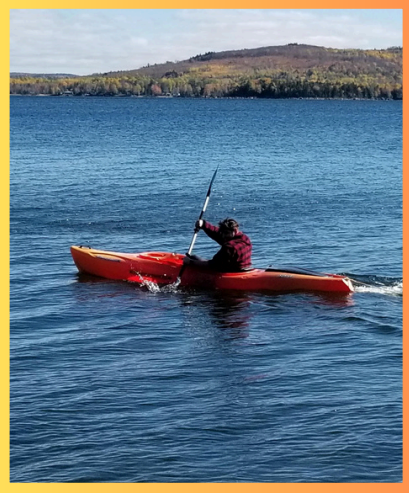
